

During this period of wintery weather, please ensure that children have appropriate outdoor clothing as we will endeavour to get the children outside for breaks and fresh air as often as possible.

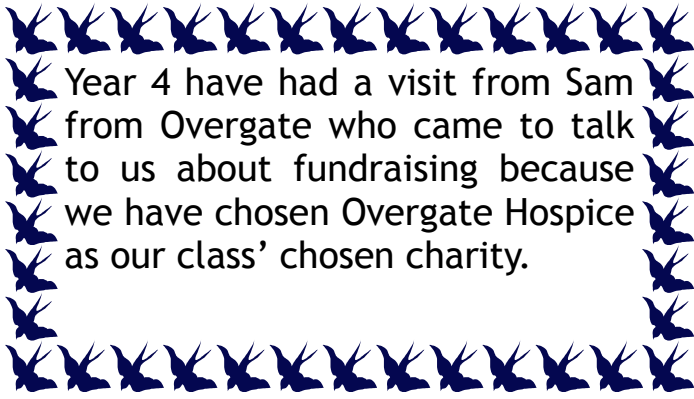


Brooksbank Talent Camp
