Dear Parents,

I am delighted that we have been invited, as a school, to take part in the Piece Hall, Big Sing event in May. The event will be the culmination of a programme of work across Calderdale, led by Calderdale Music Trust, and will involve our Year 5 and 6 children.

Next week, children in Year 6 will have a workshop focussed on the history of the Piece Hall; they will learn about the textile trade and handle historical artefacts. They will then take part in a series of sessions, composing a song. The song they produce, along with eight others written in other schools, will be learnt by a choir of over a thousand (including Year 5 children) and there will be a performance in the Piece Hall on the evening of 25th May.

This project enhances the music already taught in school by staff from the Trust and promotes us further as a Silver Sing Up school. Children also cover aspects of music linked to their topics. We are proud of our concerts and productions, and look forward to Years 3 and 4 performing their musical, Dr Dolittle, at the end of this term.

If you would like your child to learn a musical instrument, this is facilitated in school through the Trust, and of course, we also have our ukulele and Choir clubs after school.
