Dear Parents,

Next week is Internet Safety week and all children will be attending an assembly and having lessons around the theme of '**Create, Connect and Share Respect**'. This is a strong message about appropriate behaviour on line and social media and we will be thinking about the consequences of inappropriate behaviour as well as the benefits of communicating electronically. We always teach the children to '**Say no and tell**' if they see anything that upsets or worries them.

In relation to this it has come to our attention that many children are currently playing the game **Roblox** which is a very popular app. used by children (aged 5 -10). **There are aspects of this game which are not safe.** Kent Police have issued a warning following information from thousands of young children stating that they have received messages from 'strangers' asking them to be friends, and some have subsequently received 'requests to meet'. This is the case for one of our children also. Children have disclosed to the Police that they have also seen characters 'acting in very adult ways' in areas of the game.

It is strongly advised that parents of any children using this game check their accounts for 'friends' that they do not know and also for any 'meet requests', and that future use is closely monitored.

We have been invited to be in the Halifax Courier School of the Week feature. This is a good opportunity for a photograph of the whole school together; children and staff. The photographer will be in school on Monday morning to take a photo of all children with press/publicity permissions. The proposed publication date is Friday 16th February.

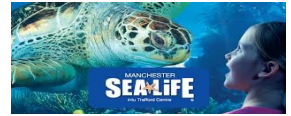
