Dear Parents,

Thank you to all those who have returned the parent survey sent out last week. It has been really positive to see the vast majority of responses to the statements (which are those used on the national Parent View survey) as **agree** or **strongly agree**. When I have received the remaining surveys from parents we will be able to collate the responses and let you know the percentages in relation to each question. If all responses could be returned at the latest by next Tuesday, the data can be collated before half term. All responses that are received by Tuesday will be included in the report that will be shared with parents after half term; based hopefully on the views of the majority of parents.

An initial consideration of the comments made by parents so far, shows a number of very clear themes around Curriculum design and learner characteristics, which we will include in our development planning, to continue to improve the provision we offer in school. This work will begin next Friday, during the INSET Day, when staff will be looking at the use of some new materials to enhance existing topics. The new units are focussed on challenge and resilience and will be piloted in the Summer Term. Staff will receive training on the units during the INSET Day and we have purchased new resources to support the implementation of this work. This will be the first aspect of our work, aiming as always to continually improve our provision for our children.

School closes next Thursday and re-opens on Monday 25th February.
