Dear Parents,

I have attached a visual illustration of the School Development Plan (SDP) for 2019-2020 to this week's newsletter. The plan is developed by senior leaders taking into account responses to parent, children, staff and Governor surveys, analysis of school data and monitoring, and external requirements such as Government and Ofsted Inspection frameworks. Some priorities you will recognise as on-going and these will continue to be a focus of the school's work; others are new. We have started work on the targets and this will continue throughout the year to ensure that as a school, the 'good' judgement we currently have is maintained as we continue to strive towards 'outstanding'.

Next week is the last week of the half term. We will finish on Thursday 24th October with our traditional Harvest Festival at St. Andrew's Church at 2pm.
